JUBILEE NOTES FOR ENTRIES

SHIRTS for Contestants! PLEASE GIVE US YOUR SIZE (Otherwise- plan on fitting into a large!)

*All contestants will wear t-shirts with their number on it **BOTH DAYS**.

SHOWERS ON SATURDAY – the High School Showers will be opened for 2 hours after the show on Saturday. Bring your towels and soap!!!

SAWS SUPPLIED – NO ADJUSTMENTS ALLOWED. CONTESTANTS MUST FURNISH CHAIN, CHAPS and EYE PROTECTION

We will be using STIHL 046 Power Saws with 28” - 50 gauge bars, 3/8 pitch, 7 tooth sprocket, 91 drivers. The saws will be pre-tuned.

Bucking Events = 23” Cottonwood. Hot saw = 23” Cottonwood.

Intermediate/master’s/women’s events = 16” Cottonwood

HOT SAW CUTTING – 3 CUTS- DOWN-UP-DOWN

SPEED CLIMB -To be eligible to place for the “OPEN” Speed Climb prize money, a competitor must finish their climb in less than 40 seconds. **If time is over 40 seconds you will receive Intermediate level payout.**

SPRINGBOARD ENTRIES WILL BE LIMITED – first 12 to apply in OPEN and first 6 to apply in MASTER/INTERMEDIATE will be in the show. Please get your entries in early.

MASTER & INTERMEDIATE SPRINGBOARD CHOP – We will have a ONE BOARD CHOP!

DUE TO SAFETY CONCERNS: ONLY contestants and needed helpers will be allowed in the arena **NO PERSONAL TIMING or CAMERA CREWS NO PETS ALLOWED IN THE ARENA**

There will be NO electric hookups for camping facilities. Camping will be in the Park. We will leave two bathrooms in the arena open at night. We also will have the school showers available – Saturday after the show for 2 hours. There will be tighter security on alcohol consumption. We cannot permit any alcoholic beverages to be in the arena or contestant areas during the show.

Morton Jubilee Rules and Regulations

1. ALL COMPETITORS MUST SIGN THE INSURANCE WAIVER.
2. All entries must be in by July 31st.
3. ENTRY FEE - \$5.00 per event. Fees are payable with entry.
4. In order to qualify, all contestants must register on Saturday morning, before the Contestant meeting
Registration time is at 8:00 am – 9:00 am.
5. ALL competitors must be at the Contestant Meeting at 9:00 am
Preliminaries start right after Meeting.
6. All ALA Rules will apply.
7. Non ALA Members need to sign up for membership at the time they send in their entry by going to www.americanlumberjacks.com and signing up online.
8. Contestants **may not enter a DIVISION lower** than their current ranking in any event.
9. The decision of the contest judges will be final in any and all matters pertaining to the contests.
10. A Contestant will be disqualified for an event if they **aren't in place within the 3 minute call**. It is the responsibility of the contestant to be listening for their event.
11. To avoid scheduling conflicts due to SHARING equipment, you must know what events you will be sharing equipment for and with whom the equipment is to be shared with. This must be included with your entry form. Heats will be run as posted. If our scheduler is unaware of equipment sharing and you are in the same heat as the one you are sharing with, only one of you will compete. Heats will not be changed on event days due to equipment sharing.
12. Competition wood is: Cottonwood for sawing and Alder for chopping
13. Stihl saws are furnished for Stock Saw – contestants must bring their own chains.
14. **Springboard Chop will be limited to the first 12 entries received.**

*****Info on how MASTER/INTERMEDIATE will be run.....

Masters and intermediate ranked competitors will be competing against each other. This is one division.

Masters must be 55+ years old any time in this competition year.

Masters/Intermediates may not enter the same event in the Open division. This year, we will run the **Master/Intermediate Springboard Chop – using ONE board. Entries will be limited to the first 6 entries received.**

ALA members are ranked.

*If you are new to ALA -you will be ranked you once you've joined.

You will only be able to compete in the division you are ranked in or above.
